What is PBIS?

PBIS stands for:

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports

- PBIS is a process for teaching children appropriate behavior and providing the supports necessary to sustain that behavior.
- PBIS is a framework to build a positive school culture.



What is PBIS?

- PBIS is used school wide
- Clear school wide expectations with incentives <u>and</u> consequences
- Actual <u>teaching</u> of Positive Behavior Expectations
- Behavioral recognition system (PBIS Rewards) for students doing <u>the right</u> <u>thing</u>



Why Choose PBIS?

- Consistent with research-based principles of behavior.
- Goal is to see an increase in positive behavior with a decrease in office referrals.
- **Prevents** the development and worsening of problem behaviors.
- Encourages the teaching and reinforcement of positive social expectations and behavior across all school settings.



How Do We Recognize Student Positive Behavior?


- The students receive a "Panda Point" when they follow the expectations.

- This helps to **reinforce** the positive behavior in our school.






